Contract student II (high) – fee per EC	€ 365	Other students

¹ Nationality Requirement:

- a. You are a national of one of the EU countries or Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland, Surinam, or
- b. You are not a national of one of the above-mentioned countries but you belong to one of the groups as mentioned in article 2.2 of the Study Financing Act 2000 (WSF 2000)

² Degree Requirement: At the start of your enrolment for a bachelor's or master's programme, you are not in the possession of a bachelor's or master's degree, obtained after September 1, 1991 at a Dutch Institute of Higher Education

³ NL/EEA/SME: from the Netherlands, European Union member state, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland or Suriname

NB. Non-NL/EEA/SME students, who pay full Institutional Tuition Fee 3 and need an extension of enrolment after their nominal study period, can receive a reduction on the tuition fee for the first 3 months of their extension. With this reduction, the tuition fee for these 3 months is equal to the Statutory Tuition Fee.

For MSc students, the discount applies in the 25th, 26th and 27th month of their registration. For BSc students the discount applies in the 37th, 38th and 39th month of their registration.

The discount is automatically processed in the invoice.

Comments on the WU fees calculations

Third year MSc non-EEA students – first 3 months and fourth year BSc non-EEA students-first 3 months

This fee is derived from the statutory fee ic1. For example 650 is derived from the statutory fee 2601. It is 2601 for the whole academic year 2025-2026, so for the first three months it is 3/12 of 2601 and that is 650 (rounded).

Third year MSc non-EEA students – after first 3 months (month 4-12)

This fee is derived from the institutional tuition fee for MSc students. For example 16425 is derived from the statutory fee 21900. It is 21900 for the whole academic year 2026-2027, so for the months 4 to 12 it is 9/12 of 21900 and that is 16425.

Fourth year BSc non-EEA students – after first 3 months (month 4-12)

This fee is derived from the institutional tuition fee for BSc students. For example 13725 is derived from the statutory fee 18300. It is 18300 for the whole academic year 2026-2027, so for the months 4 to 12 it is 9/12 of 18300 and that is 13725.

Second programme – partially simultaneous for MSc and BSc non-EEA

This group of students pay the established fee in total for the first and second programme. For example in 2026-2027 these MSc students who are following a second programme (partially) simultaneous pay 21900 for the whole academic year. So there is no extra fee for following the second programme partially simultaneous.

Second programme – sequential for MSc and BSc non-EEA

This group of students pay the established fee when they are following a second MSc programme when they started with the second programme after obtaining a degree for a MSc programme.
